### 1st Story – Come, Follow Me

#### Read: Matthew 4: 18-22

**18** And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

19 And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.

20 And they straightway left *their* nets, and followed him.

**21** And going on from thence, he saw other two brethren, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he called them.

22 And they immediately left the ship and their father, and followed him.

#### Discuss these questions:

- What job did the disciples have? (See verse 18) \_\_\_\_\_\_
- Who were the fishers that became Jesus' disciples? (See verse 18 and 21)
- What did they decide to do when Jesus asked them to follow him? (See verse 20 and 22)
- How can we follow Jesus? \_\_\_\_\_\_

### 2nd Story – The Rich Man

#### Read: Matthew 19: 16-22

**16** And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?

**17** And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? *there is* none good but one, *that is*, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.

**18** He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness,

**19** <u>Honour</u> thy father and *thy* mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

20 The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet?21 Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.

**22** But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.

- How did the Rich Man feel with the task Jesus asked of him? (See verse 22) \_\_\_\_\_
- Would you be willing to give up all that you have if the Savior asked?

### Read: Matthew 25: 1-13

**1** Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.

2 And five of them were wise, and five were foolish.

**3** They that *were* foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them:

**4** But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps.

5 While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.

6 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.

7 Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps.

8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.

**9** But the wise answered, saying, *Not so;* lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves.

**10** And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.

**11** Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us.

12 But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not.

13 Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.

- At what time was the cry made? Were the Ten Virgins ready? (See verse 6, 7, and 8)

- Could the Wise Virgins share their oil? (See verse 9)

- How can we prepare for Christ to come? (See verse 13) \_\_\_\_\_\_
