Dive into some of the commandments we are asked to keep to make a deeper connection to the song lyrics with these cute coloring pages.

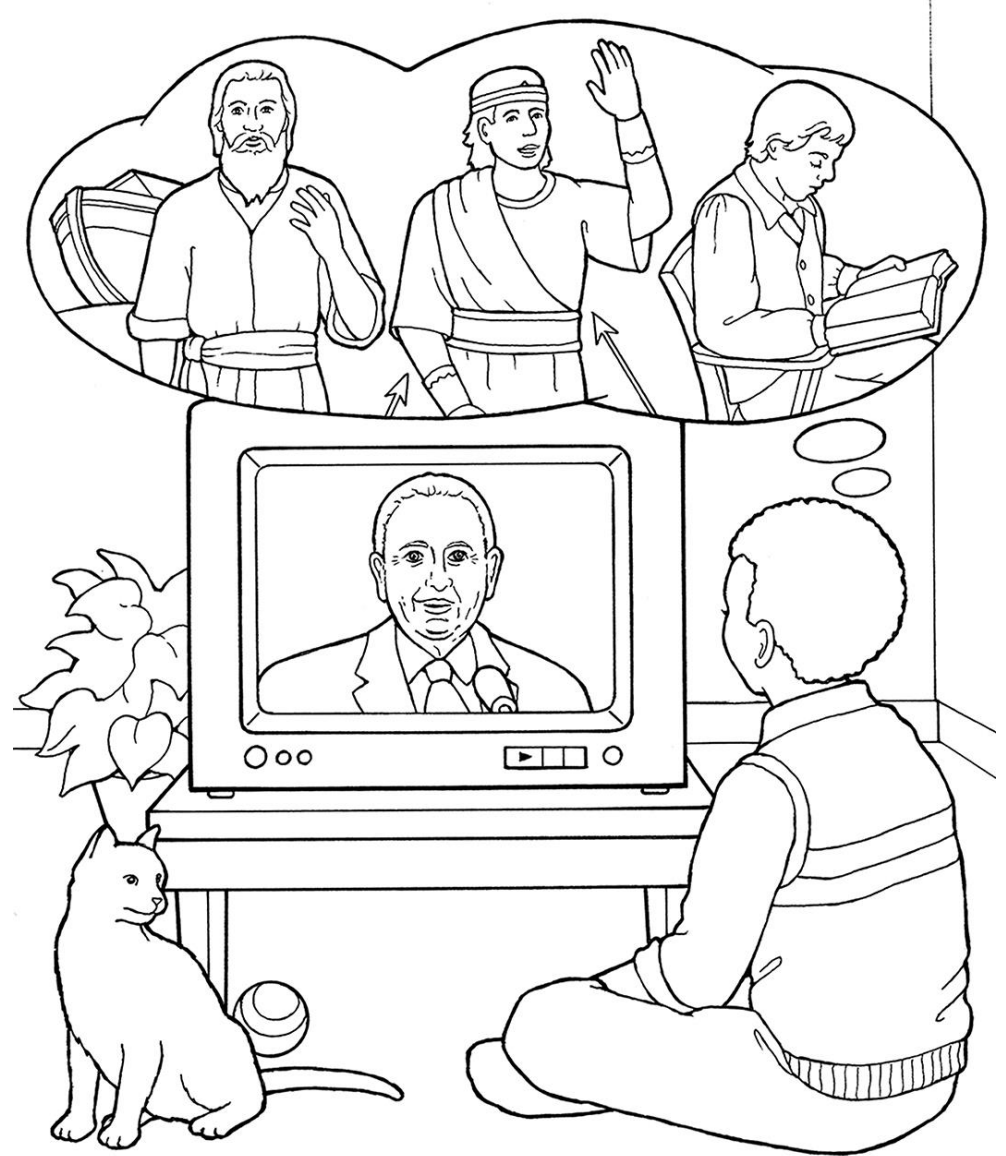

At General Conference we receive counsel from the prophet, apostles, and other leaders to help us better keep the commandments as we strive to be like Jesus.



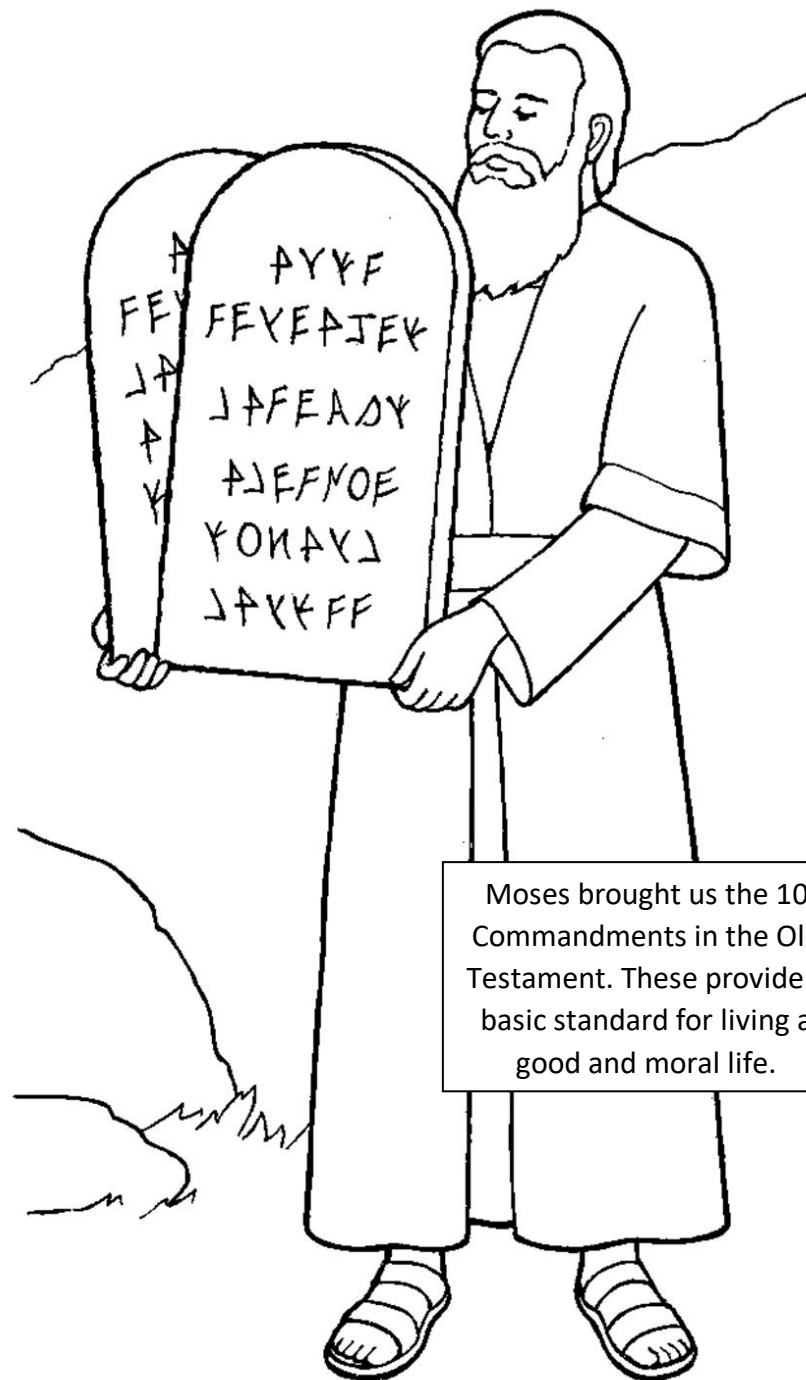
In the temple, we make covenants with Heavenly Father and come closer to Him. We can also receive direction for our lives and personal guidance we should follow.
