He Sent His Son – Singing Cupid Lesson Plan

How to Play:

- 1. Start by giving the "singing cupid" to one child.
- 2. Begin singing "He Sent His Son" and invite the children to sing along.
- 3. Instruct the children to pass the "singing cupid" to the person sitting next to them while they sing.
- 4. Have the pianist stop at a random spot in the music.
- 5. When the music stops, ask the child who is holding the "singing cupid" to say the next few words of the song. Children may choose to say or sing the words.
- 6. Continue until you complete all verses of the song.

Extension Ideas:

- Have a class competition! Have children stand up and pass the "singing cupid." When children correctly identify the next word, they can pass it on to the next person to fill in the next word. Continue until only one class is standing.
- Have 2 "singing cupids" going around the room! Children will have to keep track of two cupids and it gives them extra opportunities to guess the next words.
