

# Leprechaun Treasure Hunt with Rhyming Clues

*\*This idea and the clues were created by Richelle Lee and is shared with permission\**

- The first page helps give instruction on what item you are looking for in your Primary room and where to hide the NEXT clue they are trying to find. You can print this version then just cut off the hint at the bottom when placing it. The 2<sup>nd</sup> page has the printable without the placement helps.
- If you don't have all of the items below in your Primary room, just pick the ones fit your Primary!
- Start with the first clue on the chalkboard / whiteboard or somewhere else obvious.
- Then place the clues along the path with one clue leading to the next location with a next clue.
- Give each teacher a green card (construction paper cut into rectangles). The teachers vote on whether they sang the song good enough to advance to the next clue. If we didn't have every teacher hold their voting card up, then sing the song again before proceeding to the next clue.
- Hide something green at the end, like green tootie frooties.
- Optional fun: Use a foot paper punch and punch out green footprints to sprinkled around the floor.
