

Tell Me the Stories of Jesus

Pick a Picture

How to Play:

- Sing through the song Tell Me the Stories of Jesus before introducing your activity.
- Post your “blanks” version of Tell Me the Stories of Jesus. You can write this out on the whiteboard or simply post the included printouts. Tell the kids they’ll need to pay careful attention to the words, because you’re going to need their help to find the right picture! Sing through the song again looking for participating singers.
- Call up one child to find the picture that would fit in the first blank space.
- Continue singing your way through the song and giving the kids turns to add a picture.

Extension Activities:

- Have the children sing ONLY the picture words once you’ve finished the activity.
- Sing only as far as the word blank you’ve found, then continue through the song like this until you have added all the pictures.

Senior & Combined Primary Idea:

- For an activity better suited for younger children, try our Tell Me the Stories of Jesus - Pick a Picture activity. For combined Primary groups, I would recommend starting with Eraser Pass with the older kids, and when only ONE word is left from the row, call up a Junior Primary child to add a picture from the Pick a Picture activity next to the word row! <https://www.primarysinging.com/stories-jesus-eraser-pass/>


