I Will Walk with Jesus Learn & Teach

This fun learn & teach task is a great way to get the kids involved and hands on! The church is utilizing more ways to give the kids leadership opportunities in YM/YW and this is a really great way to extend that in a small way to Primary! The kids will love taking charge and picking out a fun way to teach the song.

How to Play:

- Sing through I Will Walk with Jesus once before beginning this activity.
- *Note: I recommend picking just one verse or the chorus for this activity during any given week. I've included all 3 verses so you can pick which one your group needs to work on.
- Divide your Primary into 4 groups. With a small Primary, you can instead divide into 2 groups and have each group learn 2 lines of the song.
- Utilize your Primary Presidency or teachers to have one adult help with each group, when possible. You can even use your Pianist if needed!
- As small groups, you'll have the children practice the line a few times through. Then, let them help you come up with a fun way to teach the lines. Here are some ideas to help you. You can also post these up on the white board and let the kids pick one of the slips and take it back to their group!
- After the kids have had 3-5 minutes to practice their part and come up with a fun way to teach, you'll call up the groups in song order and let them lead! They'll introduce their activity and teach their line of the song!
- Then, run through the whole song in sequence with all four parts (and their unique teaching ideas) together! For unscramble or missing words, you can have someone unscramble in the time it takes you to sing through the line (they'll need to be quick!) and for missing words you can have them NOT sing the missing words!

Easy Teaching Ideas:

- Clap Instead Pick words to clap instead of singing
- Pattern Pat Pat along to the rhythm
- Actions Come up with fun actions to represent the words
- Egg Shakers Shake along with the rhythm or double speed!
- Dance Scarves Create a sequence for using dance scarves
- Rhythm Sticks Use a fun pattern to represent the melody
- Unscramble Cut out the words and have the other groups put them back in order
- Missing Word Cut out 1-3 of the words, then have the other kids guess what is missing!
