

# Choose the Right Jingle Bells

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# 5 Fun Ways to Use Jingle Bells!

- 1. Shake the bells to a steady beat** - this can be done by finding the major beats of each phrase.
- 2. Shake the bells on every word!** If you have a fast song, this one can be really fun!
- 3. Up & Down** - For this one, alternate shaking the bells up high and down low. You could make cute signs for this or just point up and down when you want to switch.
- 4. Signal Word** - Choose a "signal word" from the song. This is usually a word that occurs often (Ex. the word "right" in Choose the Right). Every time you sing this song, shake your bells.
- 5. Shake & Pass** - Have children choose a partner. Each partnership receives one wrist bell and takes turns shaking the bells. The primary chorister signals when to switch.



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
