

# **I Love to See the Temple Playdoh Mats**

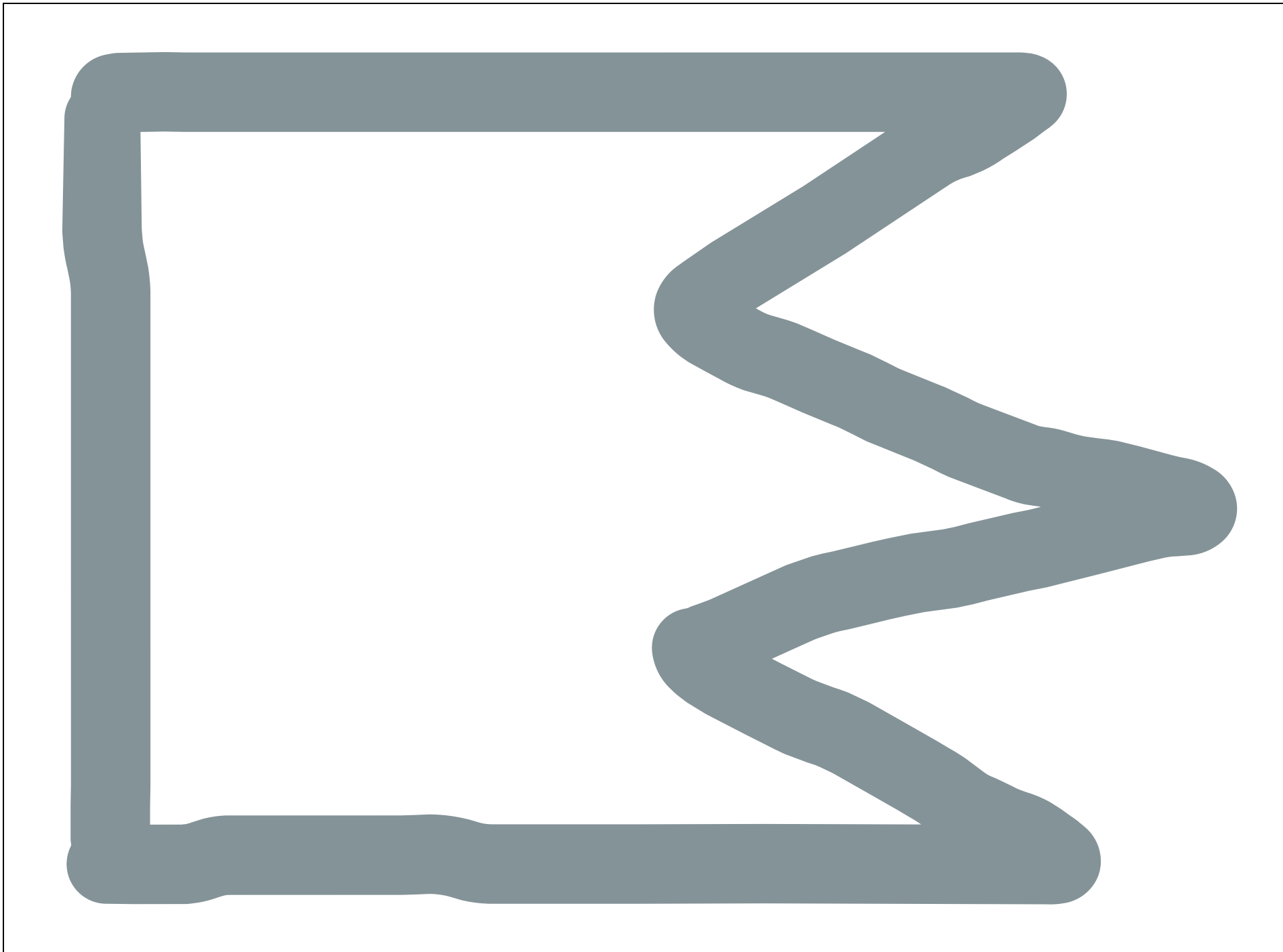
## **How to Play:**

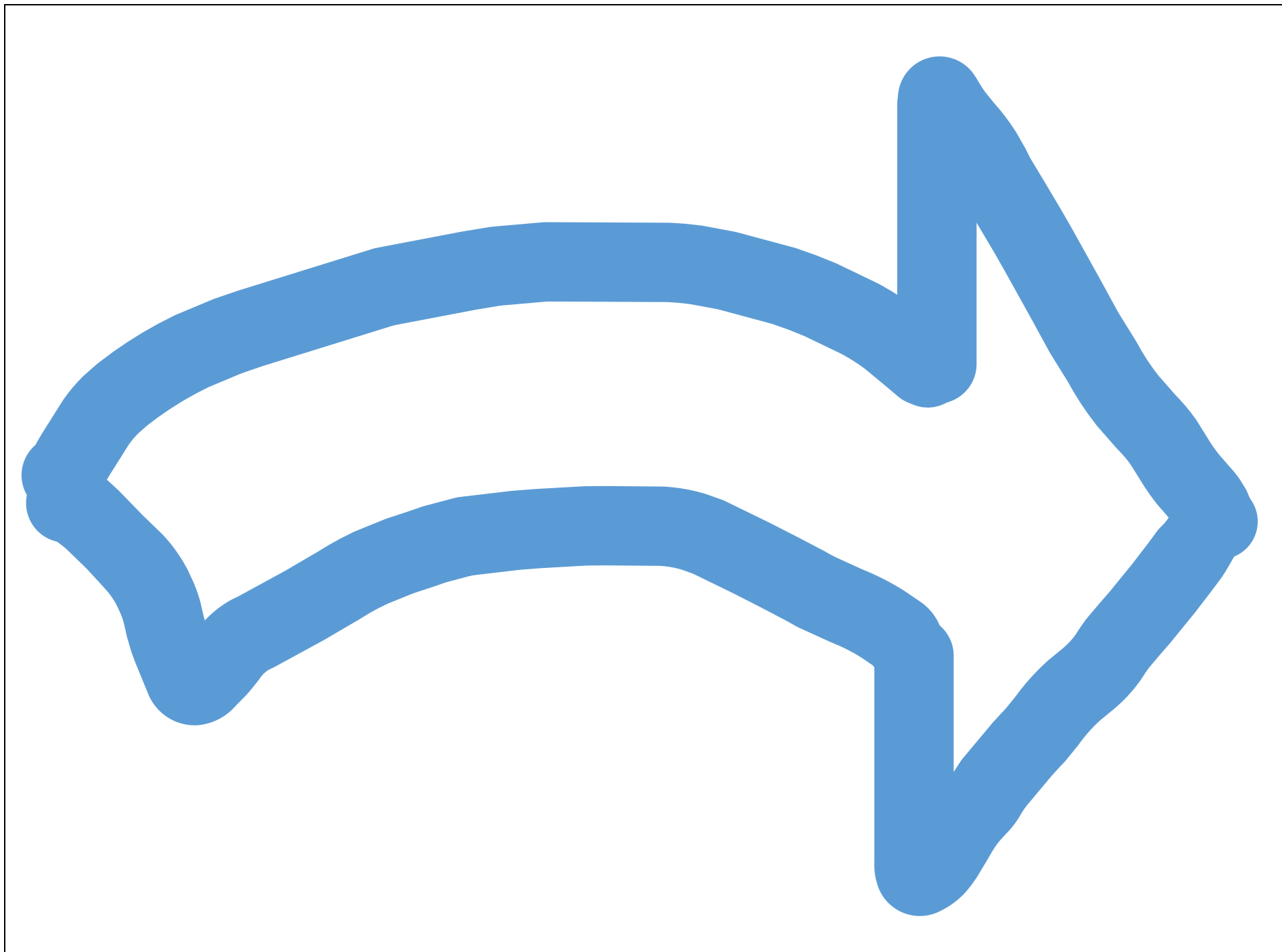
- Print you're your choice of size – full page or quarter-sheet. Then, you can laminate or stick the printed pages in a sheet protector so they're ready to be used!
- Sing through I Love to See the Temple once before introducing the activity.
- Have 1-4 helpers come up and pick a shape to create using playdoh or kinetic sand. Let them work on shaping their dough and forming the shape while the rest of the Primary sings the song again.
- Take turns having helpers come up to craft one of the 4 shapes.

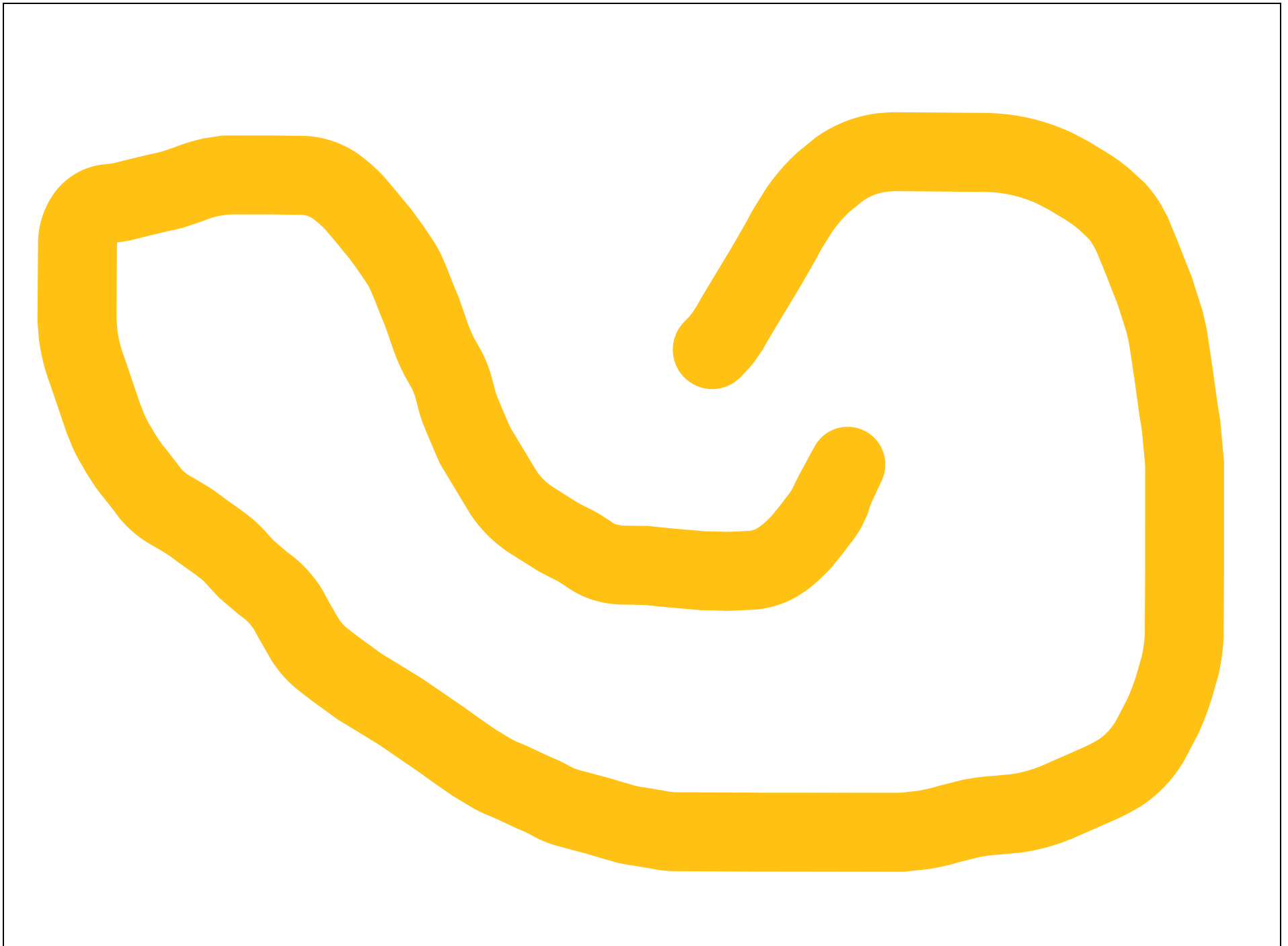
## **Extension Activities:**

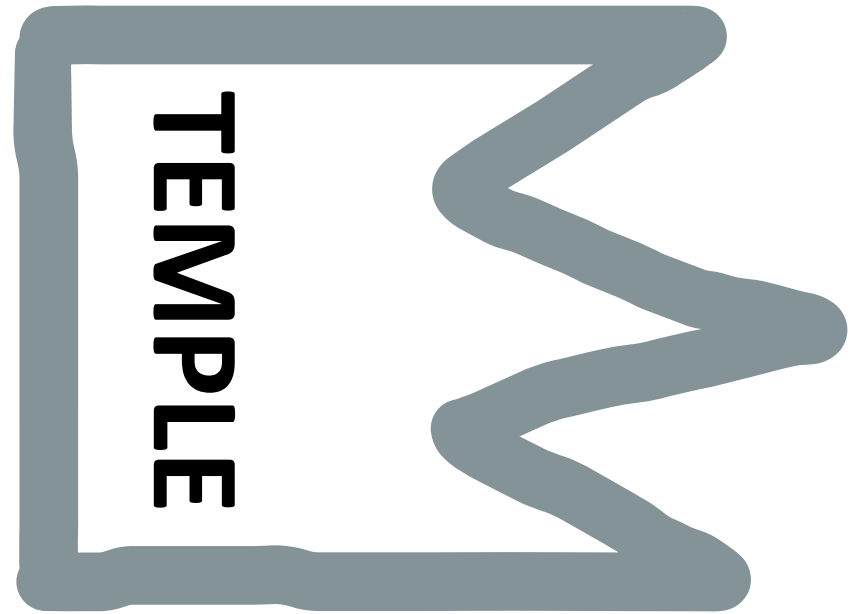
- Add hand actions for these 4 shapes to involve the rest of the kids.
  - o Love - Form a heart using your two hands – thumbs together and fingertips together.
  - o Temple - Create a temple by interlocking fingers except your two pointer fingers.
  - o Going There - Point the direction of the temple! Check your orientation before singing time so you know the direction.
  - o Listen – Cup your hand behind one ear.
- Ask the children these 4 simple questions, one after each time through the song:
  - o What do you LOVE about the temple?
  - o Do you have a favorite TEMPLE?
  - o When are you GOING to the Temple next?
  - o What's one way we can LISTEN to the Holy Ghost?
- Depending on the dough you supply, you can have the kids hold up their designs to show the Primary.
- Use the cards as a tracing stencil instead and have the kids trace the shapes and then color them in!



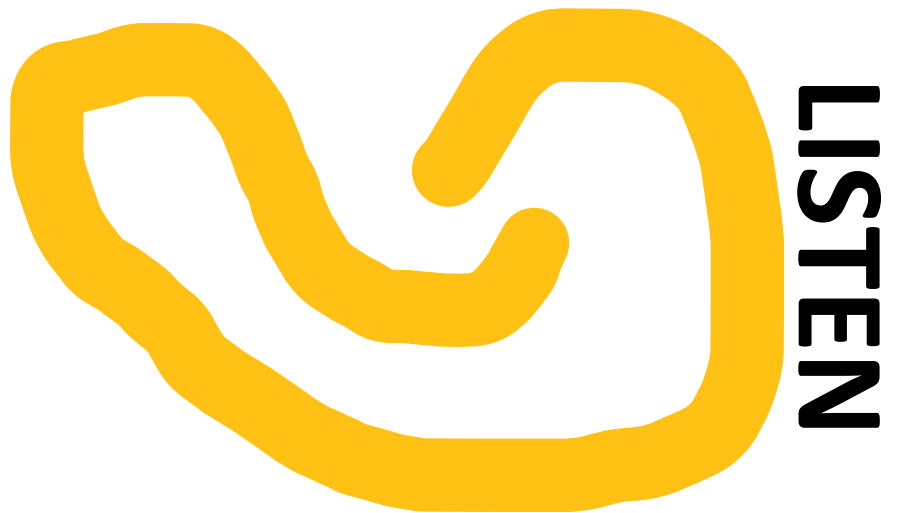
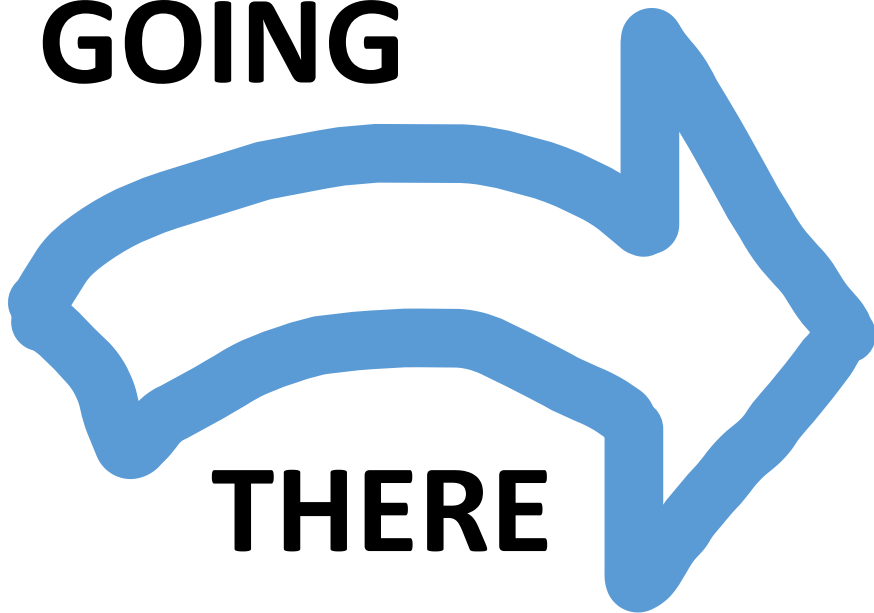


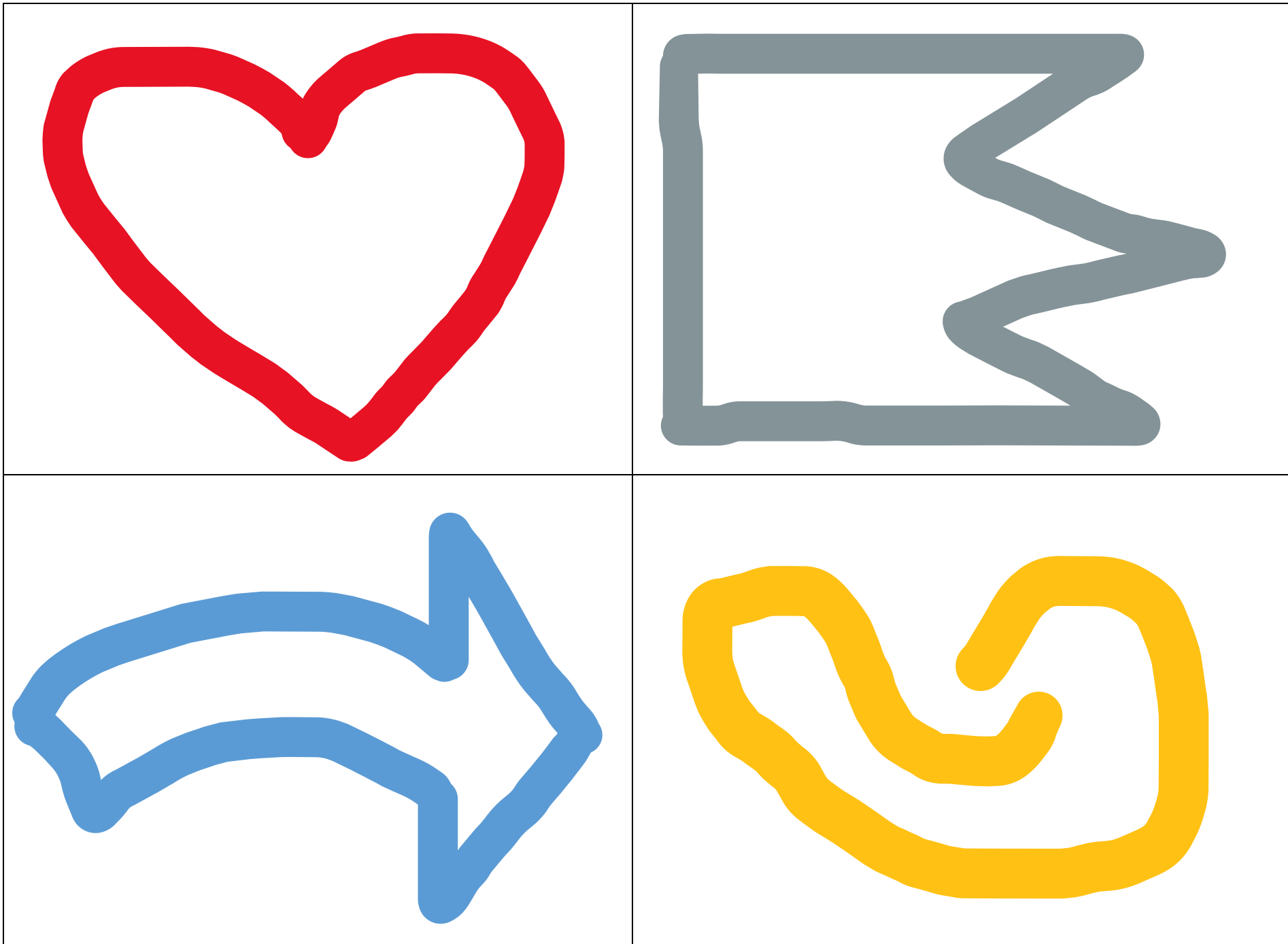
