Cut the Tie Primary Program Review!

Activity Instructions:

- 1. A few weeks before you plan to do the activity, ask a member of your Bishopric if they are willing to attend primary.
- 2. Grab a cheap tie for your visitor or ask them to bring a tie they don't want to wear again.
- 3. At the beginning of primary, choose a song from your primary program to review. Sing through the song once.
- 4. Then, invite your visitor into the room. Sing through the song again, but this time, tell the children that if they sing well, they will get to cut a small piece from his tie.
- 5. If the children sing well, have your visitor choose a child to come up and cut a small piece of his tie.
- 6. Continue practicing the same song, or switch to a new song! Have your visitor decide how short they are willing to have their tie!

Extension Ideas:

- Make it a competition! Invite two men to come into primary and split the room into two teams. As you sing through a verse, choose the side that sang the best. The team with the shortest tie at the end of primary wins!
- Create a fun way for your visitor to choose the songs! For example, you might write all your program songs on the board. Blindfold your visitor and spin him around, then have him point to a song!
- Bring in a tie for each song in your program. Whether someone is wearing the ties or not, cut each tie as you practice the songs. See which tie is the shortest at the end of primary (This activity may take 2 weeks to get through all the songs).
