

# Families Can Be Together Forever Action Words

## Activity Instructions:

1. Before primary, choose keywords in the song. Think of a simple action that can demonstrate each of those keywords. You might also look for pictures to represent the actions you've chosen.
2. At the beginning of primary, tell the children you'll be learning a new song about families.
3. Have the primary pianist play through the song. If the children are familiar with the song, invite them to sing along.
4. Then, put the action pictures on the board. Have the children look at the pictures and see if they can guess what word each picture represents.
5. Start teaching the first verse of Families Can Be Together Forever using the action words!

## Extension Ideas:

- Have the primary children add their own action words! Have them come up with some actions to add to the pattern.
- Use these action words to introduce the song! Scramble the action pictures on the board at the beginning of primary. Using the pictures, have the children try to guess what song they'll be learning!
- Split the class into a few groups. Have each group be responsible for a small section of the song. While they sing, they'll be doing the actions too.
