Print Guide:

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- Page 5: Bookmark Reading Chart – Gospels in Order

Using This Reading Chart:

- I've created these printable charts with two formats – the first follows the LDS Come, Follow Me curriculum and the second is to read the New Testament from start to finish in publication order.
- Each color represents a section of scriptures to read within your selected reading goal. It was designed to cover 12 months but can be easily grouped with several colors to meet a 4 month, 3, month, 4, week, 3 week, or other goals!
- The colors, in sequence, are red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, and then a repeat of these same 6 colors. So, for example:
 - o Come Follow Me style: The first set of red dots is month 1: Matthew 1-4, Mark 1, Luke 1-5, and John 1. The second set of red dots is month 7: Acts
 - o Read in Order style: Read Matthew in January, then Mark in February.

Come Follow Me style:

- I've followed the 2023 curriculum to create this bookmark. The readings and dates may shift slightly the next time New Testament comes around, but this should still be a relatively close and accurate guide.
- Keep in mind, some weeks of the year don't completely fall in a single month (the last of January's readings are also the 1st week of February's readings). To accommodate for that, I've added the readings to the first month to help even out the readings best except for October's which was a better divide to include with November's reading goal.
- For the weekly reading goals, you'll want to refer to the Come Follow Me manual. This reading chart will give you a very helpful year overview and monthly goals but doesn't distinguish each weekly reading.

Reading Goal:

Each color represents one block of time, with the reading chart broken down into 12 distinct sections.

- **1 Year** – Read 1st set of red dots in January (4 gospels or Matthew), Orange in February.
- **6 Months** – 1st set of Red and Orange in month 1, then Yellow and Green, etc.
- **3 Months** – Read the 1st set of Red, Orange, Yellow, and Green in month 1.
- **1 Month** – Read through Matthew & Mark, then Luke & John, followed by Acts & Romans, then divide the remaining books across the last week and a half.

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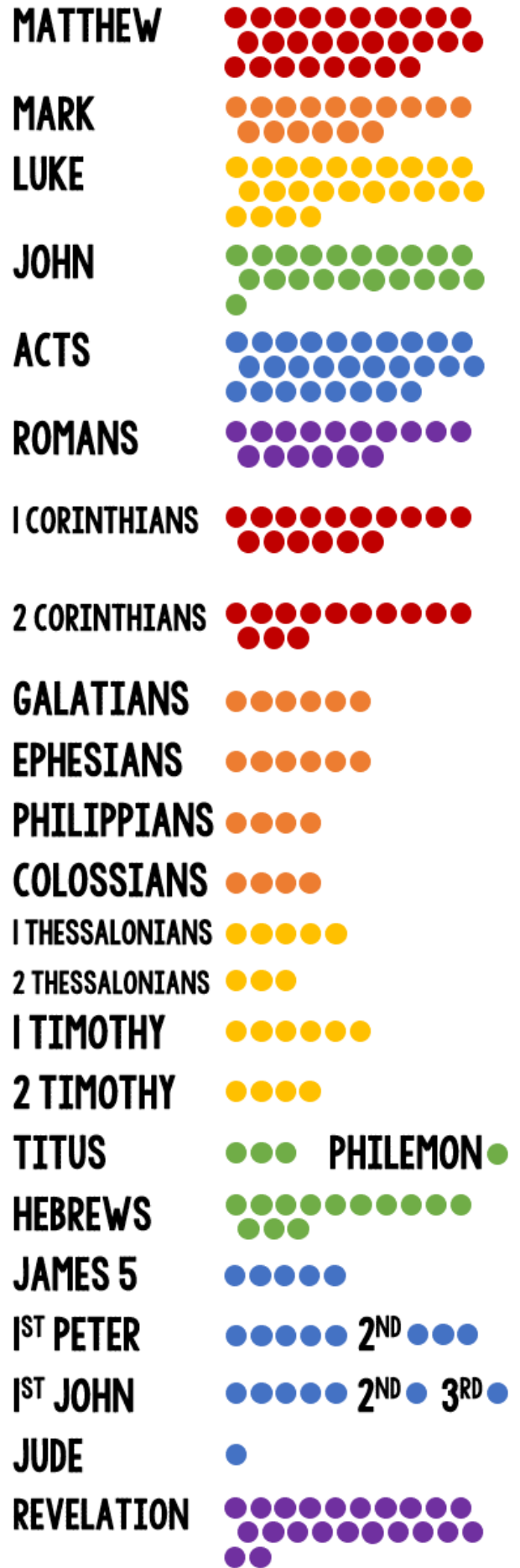
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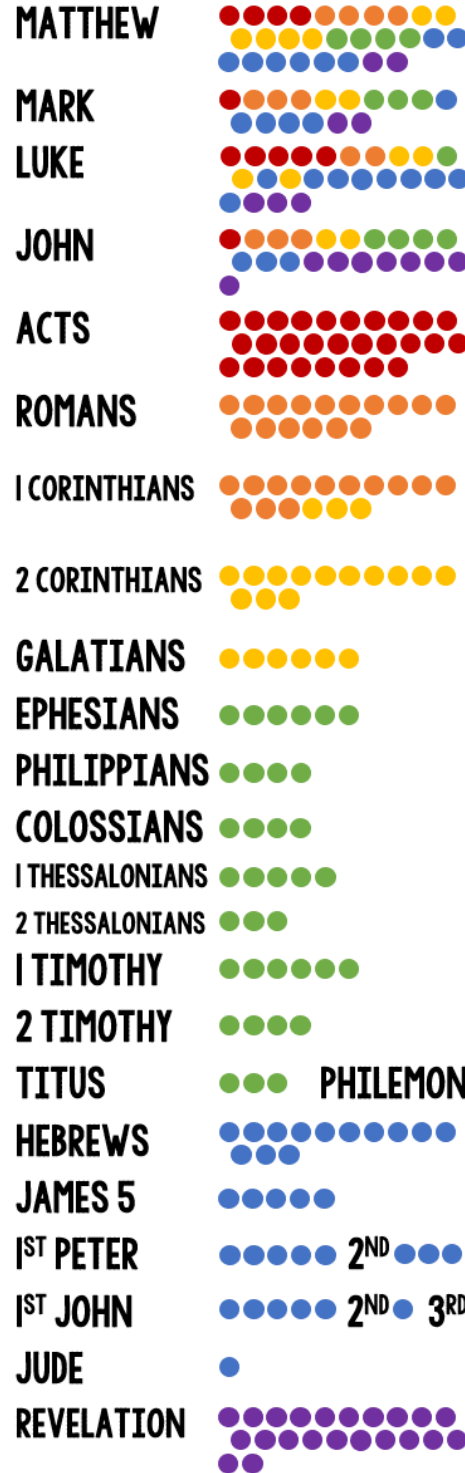
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
