(Sing) Jesus has risen, Jesus, our friend.

"Oh, I thought Easter was just the egg hunt we do on Saturday each year." Claire replies, confused. Jamie giggles and pulls out the bucket with the resurrection easter eggs. "No, silly," she said, "Easter is the time when we celebrate that Jesus was resurrected."

(Sing) Joy fills our hearts; He lives again.

"I love going to church on Easter morning because there are always really pretty songs about Jesus being resurrected," Jamie exclaims excitedly.

(Sing) Praises we sing to him, this Easter time.

"Resurr...ect... what...?" Claire tries to repeat that big word her sister just said. "What does that mean?" Jamie pulls out one of the Easter eggs from the bucket. "Here Claire, let me show you! This egg is my favorite, the gold one, because it's the last part of the story." Jamie starts, "Here, open it up!"

(Sing) Jesus has risen Savior divine.

Claire snatches the gold Easter egg out of her big sister's hand and pops it open. "Oh no!!! It's empty!! Someone lost it." Claire cries out in surprise.
