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
Pioneer Mormon Trail Info & Clues


Mormon Trail Stops:

- 1. **Sugar Creek** A major river crossing from the Mississippi river into Iowa.
- 2. Winter Quarters A settlement to say during the winter along the Missouri river.
- 3. Chimney Rock This was the largest landmark that was passed by along the route.
- Fort Bridger Here the Oregon, California and Mormon Trails split in 3 directions.
- 5. **Salt Lake Valley** The final stop was as the Pioneers reached the Salt Lake Valley.

Clues about each stop:

- 1. **Sugar Creek** You've reached a river crossing, what will you need?
- 2. Winter Quarters Whether it's summer or winter, you could stay here.
- 3. **Chimney Rock** Look at the landmark in the distance! It's pointing to the sky!
- 4. Fort Bridger We need more supplies, where could we go?
- 5. Salt Lake Valley We've made it, what do you spot down below?
