# My Mother Dear Flow Chart

## How to Play:

- This flow chart is a great way to keep things new in singing time! This chart organized the lyrics in a unique way that is sure to capture the attention of your primary children.
- I've created a printable flow chart that links keywords throughout this Mother's Day song. Simply use this chart as a teaching tool or try it as a fun review game!
- At the beginning of singing time, tell your primary children that you'll be learning a special song for Mother's Day.
- Tape the flow chart on the board and begin singing the first line as you point to the keywords, "sunshine" and "morning." Point to the next set of keywords as you sing the phrase, "that wakens day from night."
- To get some more participation, pick an older primary child to read the next two keywords. Then, sing the phrase and have the group echo after you.
- Continue moving through each set of keywords as you sing one line at a time.
- For a fun way to review the lyrics, hide some of the circles! I've included some blank circles in the printable exactly for this purpose! Pick a volunteer to come up and cover a few keywords with blank circles. Can you remember the lyrics?

## Extension Activities:

- Cover half of the keywords before singing time. Have the children guess which word is missing from each pair.
- Cut each keyword pair into word strips and scramble them on the board. As you sing, put the keyword pairs back in the correct order!
- Cut out all individual circles and pass them out. Can you find your match? Look around the room to find the person whose word goes with yours!
- Have one side of the room sing all the keywords on the left side of the flow chart and have the other side sing all the words on the right side of each flow chart.
- Choose a simple action to do each time you sing one of the keywords from the chart. Clap, Jump, Stomp, Spin, etc.
- Put the chart on the board at the beginning of singing time. Can anyone guess which song we'll be singing? Hum the melody and see if anyone already knows the song! If they do, they get to help you teach it!

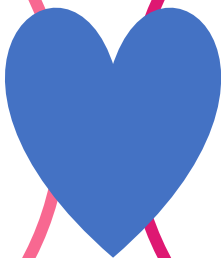

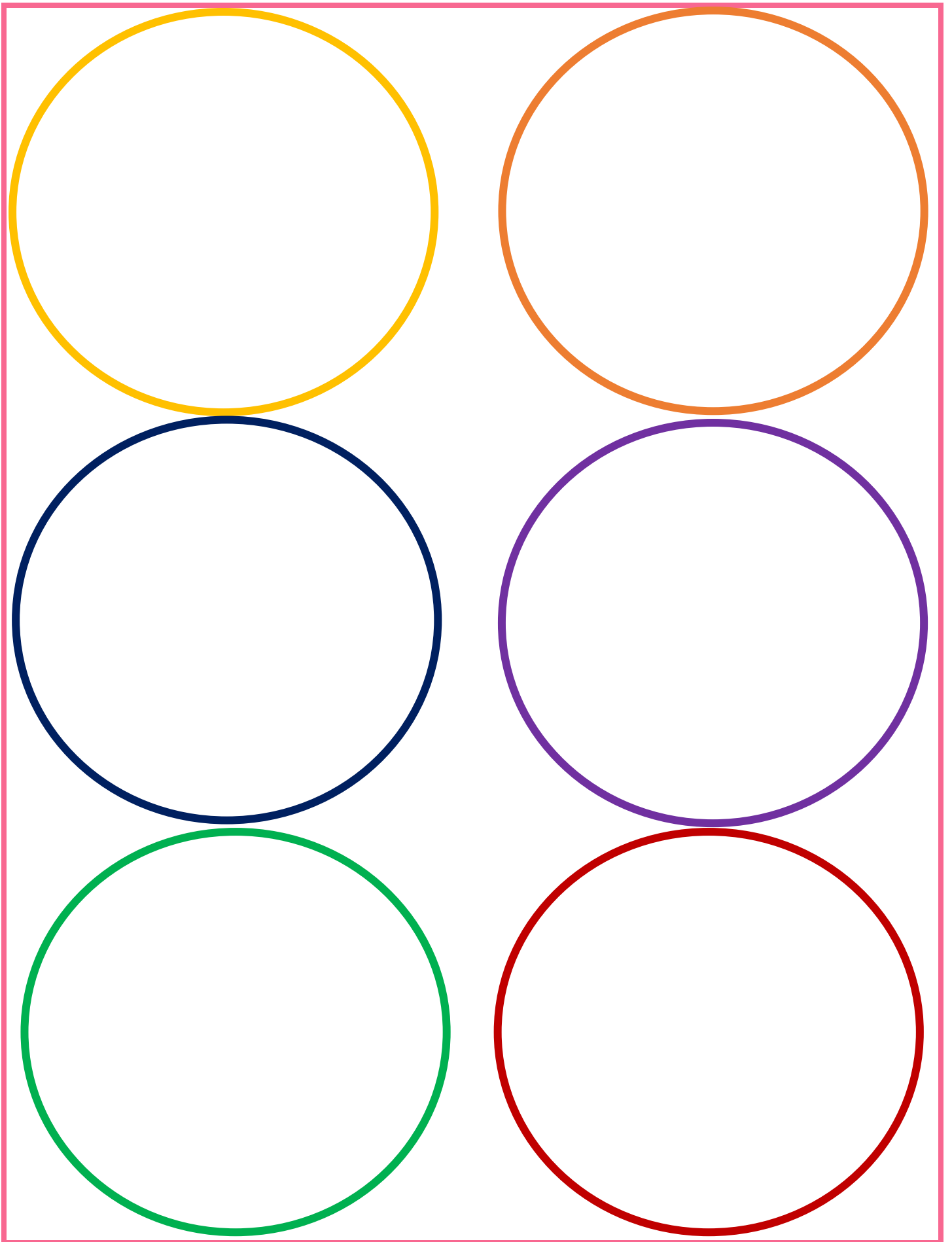
