How to Use These Song Charts:

- Print out one of two copies of the current year's song list as the front page inside or on the back of your binder so you can easily refer to it throughout the year while planning.
- Look over the list before the new calendar year and pick out which song you would like to teach throughout the year. You can highlight, make notes, add in your own songs, etc. Make a mess of it all you might need to; you can always print another fresh copy when you're ready!
- Use the additional resources below to help you with your planning and picking out which songs to include.
- After you have a plan in mind, schedule a meeting with your Primary Presidency or simply send off an email with your thoughts on the song list for the upcoming year. Take in their feedback and counsel together so everyone is on the same page. This will save you from miscommunications later and help everyone be united in the plan.
